Governments Cannot Save

Lies are the Currency of the System

The enemy is called the “father of lies” (John 8:44).
His fingerprints are all over the world's political systems — systems that run on

The rise of false peace (1 Thessalonians 5:3)

What It Means to Be a Watchman

A watchman is not consumed by elections or candidates.
