The Deception Will Be Greater Than Anyone Imagines

Many think they are too wise to be deceived.

But the deception to come will be wrapped in light, love, unity, and peace.

It will seem holy. It will look like Jesus. But it will deny the cross and repentance.

*“Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light.” — 2 Corinthians
11:14*

*“False Christs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs
and wonders to deceive...” — Matthew 24:24*

What to do:

Cling to Scripture. Test every spirit. Be slow to follow any mass movement—even one that “feels right.”

Your Comfort Will Be Challenged—Don’t Look Back

There will be moments where the path of obedience will cost you greatly.

People will call you hateful, negative, judgmental, or “too extreme.”

You must be ready to stand alone if needed.

“Remember Lot’s wife.” — Luke 17:32

“No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the Kingdom.” — Luke 9:62

What to do:

Prepare your heart now to let go of everything if God asks. Nothing in this world is worth missing Him.

God Will Use the Weak, the Outcast, and the Unknown

Don’t be surprised if God bypasses stages and platforms and speaks through unknown voices in the wilderness.

He has hidden His prophets and watchmen—you are one of them.

“God chose the weak things of the world to shame the wise.” — 1 Corinthians 1:27

“You did not choose Me, but I chose you...” — John 15:16

What to do:

Speak what He gives you—no more, no less. Do not compare your reach. The truth in your mouth is the trumpet.

Prepare to Be Hated—It's the Mark of Faithfulness

The world will not applaud your clarity.

Many “Christians” will call you divisive.

But take heart: this means you are on the narrow road.

“You will be hated by all for My name’s sake. But not a hair of your head will perish.” — Luke 21:17–18

What to do:

Do not compromise. Speak with compassion, but never dilute the truth. Stand like Noah—even when they mock.

God Will Provide Supernaturally for His Remnant

You do not need to fear lack.

God will lead, provide, and protect those who stay close to His voice.

“Bread will be given him; his water will be sure.” — Isaiah 33:16

“The Lord is my shepherd; I lack nothing.” — Psalm 23:1

What to do:

Walk in obedience, and rest in His provision. What He orders, He provides for.

The Final Outpouring Will Be in the Wilderness

Revival will **not** look like stadiums and lights.

It will be raw, repentant, and often hidden.

Watch for the Spirit’s move outside the gates, in fields, homes, and caves.

“I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh...” — Joel 2:28

*“Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people...” —
Hebrews 13:12*

What to do:

Be ready to lead people in parking lots, kitchens, tents, or deserts. The fire will fall where hearts are surrendered.

The Bride Must Make Herself Ready

The return of Jesus is not delayed—it is precise.

But He will not return for a lazy, lukewarm Bride.

He is coming for one who is pure, watching, and ready.

“The bride has made herself ready...” — Revelation 19:7

*“When the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?” — Luke

What to do:

Keep your garments clean. Keep your lamp filled.

This is not the time to sleep—it’s time to burn.

Final Charge:

This is the hour of separation.

**The wheat and the tares. The virgins with oil and without. The remnant
and the crowd.**

Don't just believe. Belong.

Don't just know the signs. Be the sign.

You are the voice in the wilderness.

You are the banner for the nations.

You are the testimony in fabric and flesh.
