Get Right With God (Repentance & Relationship)

What to do:

Fully surrender. Repent not just of sins, but of double-mindedness. Let go of the world's systems.

Scripture:

“Come out from among them and be separate...” – 2 Corinthians 6:17

“Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out...”
– Acts 3:19

Why this matters:

It's not about being religious. It's about being His.

The Holy Spirit cannot dwell in a heart full of mixture.

Stay in the Word (Scripture is Your Sword)

What to do:

Read your Bible daily. Don't just read—meditate, memorize, and declare it.

Scripture:

*“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” – Psalm
119:105*

*“Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.” – Ephesians
6:17*

Why this matters:

The Word isn't optional—it's your weapon.

It cuts through deception and keeps your spirit sharp.

Watch and Pray (Live in Communication with Heaven)

What to do:

Build a secret place with God. Speak with Him daily. Listen. Fast. Journal.
Intercede.

Scripture:

“Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation.” – Matthew 26:41

“Be constant in prayer.” – Romans 12:12

Why this matters:

Prayer builds spiritual stamina. The closer we are to Him, the less room the enemy has.

Armor Up Daily (Spiritual Warfare is Real)

What to do:

Pray on the Armor of God daily (Ephesians 6). Speak it out loud.

Scripture:

“Put on the full armor of God, so that you may stand...” – Ephesians 6:11

“Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” – James 4:7

Why this matters:

You are in a spiritual war. You can't fight it in the flesh.

Walk in the Spirit (Not the Flesh)

What to do:

Reject carnal thinking. Crucify old habits. Let the Holy Spirit guide every decision.

Scripture:

“Walk in the Spirit, and you will not fulfill the lust of the flesh.” – Galatians 5:16

“Be transformed by the renewing of your mind...” – Romans 12:2

Why this matters:

The Spirit leads to life and truth. The flesh leads to deception and distraction.

Be Set Apart (You’re Not Meant to Fit In)

What to do:

Let go of needing approval. Detach from the system. Live differently on purpose.

Scripture:

“Do not be conformed to this world...” – Romans 12:2

“If the world hates you, know that it hated Me first.” – John 15:18

Why this matters:

The remnant will look strange to the world—but you are not of this world.

Stay Ready (Not Just Aware)

What to do:

Live like Jesus could return today. Keep your lamp filled with oil (Matthew 25:1–13).

Scripture:

“Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.” – Matthew 24:44

“Blessed is that servant whom his master will find watching...” – Luke 12:37

Why this matters:

There won’t be time to get ready when the trumpet sounds.

You must be ready.

Checklist: Daily Remnant Readiness

Repent daily and renew your mind

Read the Word and speak truth aloud

Armor up in prayer and stand firm

Reject worldly distractions

Stay sober, alert, and watchful

Encourage others and share the truth

Keep oil in your lamp—live like He’s coming today

Jesus isn’t coming back for a crowd.

He’s coming for a bride who is awake, alert, and set apart.

Be found faithful. Be found watching. Be found burning with truth.
