The Abraham Accords, a series of peace agreements brokered by the United States in 2020 under President Donald J. Trump. These treaties normalized diplomatic relations between Israel and several Arab nations.

Including:

United Arab Emirates (UAE)

Bahrain

Sudan

Morocco

Before 2020, only Egypt (1979) and Jordan (1994) had formal, fully implemented peace treaties with Israel. For decades, such peace seemed impossible due to longstanding conflict between Israel and the Arab world. But Suddenly—and shockingly to many—other Arab nations embraced diplomacy of peace, prosperity, and “regional stability.”

What's Hidden in the Name?

The name “Abraham Accords” is deeply symbolic—and spiritually revealing.

Abraham is the patriarch claimed by all three major monotheistic religions:
Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

The accords seek to unite the “children of Abraham” under the banner of peace
and mutual respect.

But for those with discernment, this unity raises red flags:

A false peace cloaked in brotherhood

A unity built on shared heritage—but not shared truth

A peace agreement that excludes Jesus, the very Prince of Peace

Prophetic Risk

By initiating these accords, Trump gained trust from both Israel and Muslim nations, creating a potential foundation for a future global covenant—one that could evolve into the very 7-year peace treaty prophesied in Scripture.

"He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation..."— Daniel 9:27

This covenant appears to be in alignment with the final Antichrist, who will:

Confirm or expand a 7-year peace agreement

Use it to establish religious unity, possibly involving the Vatican or a global religious figure

Eventually betray the covenant, enter the Temple, and declare himself God (see Matthew 24:15, 2 Thessalonians 2:4)

A Counterfeit Peace

Though the Abraham Accords were praised for ushering in peace.

Scripture warns us:

"While people are saying, 'Peace and safety,' destruction will come on them suddenly..."— 1 Thessalonians 5:3

This is not true peace—it is deception.

It promotes unity apart from Christ

It unites Jews, Muslims, and others without repentance

It excludes the Cross, salvation, and the Name above every name

Trump's Role: Cyrus... or Forerunner?
