

What's Been Fulfilled and What's Still to Come

Nearly **30% of Scripture is prophetic**, containing over **8,000 verses** that reveal God's sovereign plan from **creation to eternity**.

Prophecies Fulfilled: Where We Are in the L'ord's Timeline

"I am God, and there is none like Me, declaring the end from the beginning..." — Isaiah 46:9–10

Where We Are in God's Timeline

The Abrahamic Covenant

Genesis 12, 15, 17

Prophecy:

God promised Abraham that his descendants would:

- Become a great nation
- Be enslaved for 400 years
- Inherit the land of Canaan

Fulfillment:

- ✓ Israel enslaved in Egypt for over 400 years
 - ✓ Moses leads the Exodus
 - \checkmark Joshua enters the Promised Land
 - ✓ The nation of Israel is born

This covenant laid the foundation for all future prophetic fulfillment.

Israel's Babylonian Captivity

Jeremiah 25:11-12; Daniel 9

Prophecy:

• Israel would be taken captive in Babylon for 70 years.

Fulfillment:

- ✓ Jerusalem destroyed in 586 BC
 - ✓ Israel taken into exile
- ✓ After 70 years, under King Cyrus, the remnant returns and rebuilds (Ezra/Nehemiah)

The Coming of the Messiah

Isaiah 7, 9, 53; Daniel 9:24-27

Prophecy:

- Virgin birth
- Rejected, suffer, and die
- Daniel's 70 Weeks pinpoints His arrival

Fulfillment:

- ✓ Jesus born of a virgin
- ✓ Entered Jerusalem on a donkey (Zechariah 9:9)
 - ✓ Rejected and crucified (Psalm 22, Isaiah 53)
- ✓ "Cut off" in the 69th week of Daniel's prophecy

We now live in the pause—the Church Age—before the 70th week resumes.

Destruction of the Second Temple

Matthew 24:2; Luke 21:6

Prophecy:

 \bullet Jesus foretold the Temple would be destroyed.

Fulfillment:

 \checkmark In 70 AD, Rome destroyed the Temple—exactly as Jesus said.

The Diaspora

Deuteronomy 28:64; Luke 21:24

Prophecy:

• The Jewish people would be scattered among the nations.

Fulfillment:

✓ After 70 AD, Jews were dispersed worldwide, with no homeland for nearly 2,000 years.

The Rebirth of Israel

Isaiah 66:8; Ezekiel 37:21-22; Matthew 24:32-34

Prophecy:

• Israel would become a nation again—in a single day.

Fulfillment:

✓ May 14, 1948 – Israel reborn in one day, fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy.

This is the super-sign of the final generation.

"This generation shall not pass..." — Matthew 24:34

(Psalm 90:10: A generation = 70-80 years $\rightarrow 1948 + 80 = 2028$)

We are now living within this final prophetic window.

The Return of Hebrew

Zephaniah 3:9

Prophecy:

• God would restore to His people a "pure language."

Fulfillment:

✓ Hebrew was revived from extinction and is now Israel's national language—the only language in history to be restored this way.

The Rise of Global Technology & Knowledge

Daniel 12:4

Prophecy:

• "Knowledge shall increase... and many shall run to and fro."

Fulfillment:

✓ The digital age: internet, AI, satellites, global travel—all signs preparing the stage for prophecy like the Mark of the Beast and global surveillance.

The Alignment of Nations

Ezekiel 38-39

Prophecy:

• A coalition of nations (Gog and Magog) will rise against Israel.

Fulfillment in Progress:

- ✔ Russia, Iran, and Turkey are aligning—just as prophesied.
 - ✓ Tensions surrounding Israel are intensifying globally.

Explosion of Travel

Daniel 12:4

Prophecy:

• "Many shall run to and fro..."

Fulfillment:

✔ Planes, trains, automobiles—global travel is constant, fulfilling Daniel's words literally.

Global Lawlessness & Moral Collapse

2 Timothy 3:1-5

Prophecy:

• "In the last days, perilous times will come..."

Fulfillment:

✔ Breakdown of the family, confusion of gender, idolization of self—Paul's warning is now our reality.

The Great Falling Away (Apostasy)

1 Timothy 4:1-2; 2 Thessalonians 2:3

Prophecy:

• There will be a great falling away before the end.

Fulfillment:

- ${\color{red} \checkmark}$ Modern churches preach comfort over conviction.

Where Are We Now? Understanding the Prophetic Window

"So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors!" — Matthew 24:33

The Church Age (Age of Grace) Is Almost Complete

We are living at the *tail end* of what Scripture calls the Church Age—a divine pause between Daniel's 69th and 70th weeks—when salvation is freely offered to the world through Jesus Christ.

But this season will not last forever.

There is coming a moment when God will say, "Enough." The Church will be taken, the world will shift, and the final countdown will begin.

Daniel's Prophetic Timeline and the "Final Generation"

According to **Daniel 9:24–27**, there is a prophetic timeline of 70 weeks (of years). The first 69 weeks were fulfilled with the coming and crucifixion of Jesus. We are now living in the *pause* before the final 70th week—also known as:

The **Time of Jacob's Trouble**The **7-Year Tribulation**

"This generation shall not pass till all these things be fulfilled."— Matthew 24:34 Jesus pointed to **the blooming of the fig tree (Israel)** as the key marker of the last generation.

Psalm 90:10 and the Generational Window

"The days of our years are threescore years and ten [70]; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years [80]..." — Psalm 90:10

1948 – Israel becomes a nation

1948 + 70 = 2018 (Beginning of final window)

1948 + 80 = 2028 (End of generation marker)

We are now living in the final prophetic window.

Key Timeline Markers

1948 — Israel becomes a nation in a single day (Isaiah 66:8 fulfilled)

1967 — Jerusalem is recaptured (Luke 21:24)

2018 — Marks 70 years since Israel's rebirth—beginning of final window

2020–2022 — Global shaking: pandemic, unrest, economic turmoil

2020–2023 — Rise of false peace (Abraham Accords)

2024 — Political upheaval, spiritual polarization increasing

2025 — Awakening for some, falling away for many (2 Thess. 2:3)

2028 — 80 years since Israel's rebirth—potential closure of the final generation window

These are not predictions of exact dates for the Rapture or Second Coming—but clear prophetic indicators for those watching.

What Happens After 2028?

We are entering **uncharted territory**—but prophecy gives us two likely scenarios:

- ♦ 1. The Rapture & Tribulation Begin Before or Around 2028
 - The Church is removed
 - The Antichrist rises
 - A 7-year peace covenant is confirmed (Daniel 9:27)
 - The Great Tribulation begins

If the final generation ends in 2028, it is highly likely that the Rapture and the beginning of the 70th Week of Daniel will occur **just before or by this time.**

◆ 2. God's Timing May Extend Slightly Beyond 2028

While the "final generation" may align with 2028, we must remember:

- God is not bound to Gregorian dates
 - He may extend mercy
- The timing could be from Jerusalem's recapture (1967) rather than 1948
- Or the Tribulation may begin inside the generation window—not after

Where We Stand Today

"When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." — Luke 21:28

We are now in a season of:

Rapid prophetic fulfillment

Global deception and spiritual falling away

Remnant awakening and preparation

You were born for this hour.

The generation that saw the fig tree bloom *will not pass*—and we are watching that Word come alive in real time.

What's Still to Come — A Look at the Final Events in Bible Prophecy

"Surely the Lord God does nothing unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets." — Amos 3:7

The Rapture of the Church

Verses: 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, 1 Corinthians 15:51-52

Description: Jesus comes for His bride. Believers in Christ—dead and living—are caught up to meet Him in the air.

Purpose: To **spare the faithful** from the wrath to come (*Revelation 3:10*) and to reunite the bride with her Bridegroom.

The Rise of the Antichrist & the 7-Year Covenant

Verses: Daniel 9:27, Revelation 13, 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4

Description: A charismatic global leader emerges (Antichrist) and confirms a 7-year covenant with many, initiating the Tribulation.

At 3.5 years, he breaks the covenant, enters the rebuilt Temple, and declares himself to be God. (Abomination of Desolation)

The Great Tribulation (Final 3.5 Years)

Verses: Matthew 24:21–22, Revelation 6–18

Description: The most intense period of wrath, judgment, persecution, and destruction in history.

God's judgments are poured out

The Antichrist wages war on believers

A remnant will come to faith—but it will cost them everything

The Second Coming of Jesus Christ

Verses: Revelation 19:11-16, Zechariah 14:4

Description: Jesus returns **with His saints**, defeats the Antichrist and false prophets, and **establishes His Kingdom on earth**.

"Every eye will see Him..." (Revelation 1:7)

The Millennial Reign of Christ (1,000 Years of Peace)

Verses: Revelation 20:1-6

Description: Jesus physically reigns on earth for 1,000 years.

Satan is bound. Peace and justice prevail.

The curse is lifted. Righteousness governs the nations.

The Final Judgment & Eternal Destiny

Verses: Revelation 20:11-15, Revelation 21

Description:

The Great White Throne Judgment

All who rejected Jesus are judged

Satan is thrown into the lake of fire

A new heaven and a new earth are created

God dwells with His people forever

Before the End of This Generation Window, These Events Must Begin:

➤ The Church Age Must Close

Rapture of the faithful remnant

Apostasy and awakening run side by side

➤ Daniel's 70th Week Must Begin

Antichrist confirms a 7-year covenant

World enters the Tribulation

➤ The Temple Must Be Rebuilt in Jerusalem

Preparations already underway:

Red heifers, Priestly garments, Temple vessels, Levitical training

What Should We Do in This Hour?

Prepare souls

Call out deception

Proclaim truth

Declare repentance

Raise banners, not brands

Stand as a voice when others are whispering comfort

"And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever." — Daniel 12:3

We Are the Final Generation

"NOW WHEN THESE THINGS BEGIN TO TAKE PLACE, STRAIGHTEN UP AND RAISE YOUR HEADS, BECAUSE YOUR REDEMPTION IS DRAWING NEAR." — LUKE 21:28 We are closer to the return of Jesus than any generation before us.

The signs are not merely *approaching*—

They are here.

And you have not been placed in this moment by accident.

You were chosen to live in this hour—for a reason.

You are part of the remnant, the watchmen, the voice in the wilderness crying out:
