Be a Living Testimony

Declare Truth, Even if They Don’t Listen

Speak what God gives you. Warn with compassion. Plant the seed.

Speak truth in conversations, even when uncomfortable

Share warnings and testimonies through video or blog

Host small gatherings for prayer, worship, and equipping

Store practical supplies if led—especially for others who may need help

Above all:

Love deeply, give freely, and live with eternity in mind
